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MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION OF FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY The Name of the Society Shall be "FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY" 2.Registered Office: The Registered Office of the Society will be situated at P 35/ A , Avenue, Dum Dum, Kolkata -700 074. 3. Object :- The object for which the Society is founded is to bring within its fold and to co-ordinate the activities of the various Photographic Associations, Clubs, and Societies in India, working to faster, encourage and promote interest in the Art and for Science of Photography in all its aspects and the applications thereof for the benefit of the Public in general irrespective of Caste, Creed , religion or Sex, The area of operation will be restricted within the State of West Bennal. The said object is sought to be attained :a) By forming the Society with the existing Photographic Associations, Clubs and Societies as are subscribing to the above object, without prejudice to their individual identity and internal autonomy, as Corporate Members: b) By enrolling from time to time as Corporate Members such Photographic Associations, Clubs and Societies as may now be in existence or as may be formed in future , whenever the may on subscribing to the above objectseek addition c) By holding regional and periodical conventions in Photography at Various Centres in India by rotation; d) By promoting conducting or holding Photographic Competitions, Portfolios, exhibitions and Salons. by aiding the Corporate members to organise them by rotation; b) By appointing a panel of Judges from which any Corporate Member organising a selon may choose its personnel lo - PBy Circulating foreign portfolios, exhibitions and Salons among the corporate Members. @ g) By maintaining an information bureau with regard to all matters pertaining to Photography; If By encouraging research in Photography by the people irrespective of caste and creed as well as by the groups of People. Societies, Institutes interested for scientific research in Photography By publishing engine papers as well as Journals, periodicals, annuals and books on Photography; Annuals By making representations to proper authorities to redress the grievances of Corporate Members as well as individual photographers (k) By contening or awarding honours, degrees and diplomas on individual Photographers of Ment Ar By establishing a National Museum Of Photography and a National Gallery Of Photographic Art and by reviving ancient culture on Photography.  - The Incomes and Properties of the Society whatsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society and no portion thereof shall be paid to or divined amongst any of its members by way of Profit, Dividend, provided that nothing herein conteined shall prevent the payment in good faith or remuneration of any employees of the Society or other person in return for any services rendered to the Society.

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Interpretation: - In these Rules and Regulations, unless there is anything repugnant to the context: -

- a) Court: The word * Court * means the Principal Civil Court Of Original Jurisdiction of the District within which the Registered Office Of the Society is situated .All disputes are with in the jurisdiction of High Court Of Kolkata.
- b) Society: the word * Society * means FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY and its associates, if any.
- c) Governing Body: It means the body, by whatever name called entrusted with the Management Of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY
- d) Member: It means a person who has been admitted with his consent as a member inaccordance with the Rules and Regulations Of the FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY and includes Corporate Members, Clubs, Association and Societies.
- e) Memorandum: It means the Memorandum Of Association Of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY
- 1) Butes and Regulations: It includes Standing Orders that may be framed hereafter under the provisions of these Rules and regulations.
- g) The word importing the masculine gender shall be deemed to refer also feminine gender. Chapter –II
- 1. PATRONS: Any person having sympathy with the aims and objects of F I P and whose association with the Society is deemed necessary may be admitted as a Patron with or without payment of Fees, subscription and donation. The Patrons may disconnect the relation with the Society after giving a three-month's notice in advance to FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY in writing. The Following persons will be the First Patron of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY.
- 2. MEMBERSHIP: -
- a) Admission

 The signatories of the Memorandum of Association of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY and the office bearers of the Governing Body shall be the First Members Of the FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY. The Governing Body may admit to membership any person of any caste creed, religion or sex who has attained the age of 18 years and agreed in writing to become the member inaccordance with the Memorandum and Rules and Regulations of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY. The Association, Trusts, Societies, Clubs etc may also be admitted as a member of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY. Be it noted here that the power to admit member is the solvand absolute discretion of the Governing Body. The Governing Body may refuse to admit any person, clubs trusts, association as a member without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- b) Types of Members: Honorary Members: Any person whose connection with the Society is deemed to be useful may with the consent of such person be taken as Honorary Member of the Society without payment of any fees, subscription and donation. Such Member shall not however be eligible to the member of the Governing Body nor shall be entitled to Vote in any Meeting

Ordinary Members: Any person qualified to be a member may be admitted as ordinary member on payment of Scheduled Fees. The Fees for admission and annual subscription may from time to time be fixed by the Governing Body and that must be ratified by General Body. The ordinary member shall have the right to Vote in the meeting provided there is no outstanding dues on account of Membership Fees and Subscription. Joint Members may be accepted but they will be treated as a single member at the time of Cesting Vote. The Representative of each Corporate Members may caste Vote as a single member.

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- 3. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP :- Any Member shall cease to be a Member -
- i) On the acceptance of his /her resignation from Membership,
- ii) On his /her becoming insane , insolvent or for conviction of any offence involving moral turpitude
- iii) Fallure to renew the membership and or is a defaulter in paying his dues. The membership may be removed after expiry of 60 Days from the date of despatch of notice , directing him/her to pay the dues, provided that no such removal shall take effect without the approval of the Governing Body.
- 4.REGISTER OF MEMBERS : The Governing Body shall maintain a Register Of Members containing the Names, Addresses, Occupation, date of admission and Cessation of Membership. The Register of members shall be kept open for inspection of the Members at a free of Cost on requisition and a notice in writing which is to be received at least 15 days in advance by the President/Secretary,
- 5. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATION OF MEMBERS : Any ordinary member of the Society has the right (a) to elect and to be elected in any election of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY (b) to submit suggestion for discussion to the Governing Body and sub-committee on any matter relating to the Society: (c) to inspect the accounts and the proceedings of the meeting on prior appointment with the President /Secretary . (d) to pay his/her subscription within the prescribed time. Defaulting Members shall not be allowed to take part or vote in a meeting. Each Member including Joint Member shall have one
- 6. EXPULSION AND REMOVAL :- Fraudulent action of any Member if found by the Governing Body which is detrimental to the interest and is in violation of the Rules and Regulation Of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY, he/she may be after due enquiry censured, suspended or expelled from the Membership . In that case the Governing Body shall serve the Member concerned with a show cause notice stating the charges framed and ask him/her to submit his/her statement of defence within a month or such shorter period as the Governing Body may deem fit. If thereafter it is proved to the satisfaction of the Governing Body that the allegation against the member is correct, the member shall be expelled forthwith.

CHAPTER -III

- 7. GOVERNING BODY :- The Management of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY shall subject to the Rules , be in charge of the Governing Body constituted in the manner laid down hereafter and responsible to the General Body of the Society. The Governing Body shall meet at least once in three Calendar months.
- 8. FORMATION AND ELECTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY :- The Governing Body shall consist of bat least 5 (Five) members and he limited to 50 members. The Governing Body shall be elected amongst the Ordinary members and Life members. The Governing Body ordinarily constituted for (Three) Years shall continue in the office until a new committee is elected or it is dissolved otherwise. The President and the Secretary of the branch shall be Ex-officio members of the Governing Body, and that they shall not be counted in the prescribed limit of 50 (lifty) members in the Governing Body.
- 9. POWERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY :- (1) The Governing Body shall have the Power to run the Society for the attainment of its Objects on behalf of the Members .
- (2) The Governing Body shall have the power to elect the Executive Committee among the Governing Body members.

(3) The Governing Body shall have the power to elect any office bearer of the Executive Committee in the event of any Casual. Vacancy caused by the demise or resignation or any other act on the part of any office bearer. (4) The Governing Body shall formulate the election procedures and shall be responsible for conducting the same.

(5) The Governing Body shall elect the Executive Committee in a meeting duly convened for the purpose by the President of the Outgoing. Committee.

10. OFFICE BEARERS: The bearers of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY shall consist of the fallowing .-

(1) One President - The President of the Society shall be so chosen that he or she shall be a person with distinguished calibre and personally in the opinion of the Majority number of members present in the First Annual General Meeting . As/a mark of respect to the president so elected, the Society shall constitute to nin under his/her President ship throughout his/her. lifetime unless he or she intends at any point of time to disassociate himself herself wilfully with the activities of the Society and for any member thinks otherwise

(ii) Not more than 2 (two) Vige-President

(iii) One Secretary General/

(IV) One Assistant Secretary

(v) No more than 2 (two) Joint Secretaries.

(vi) One Treasurer



11. POWER AND DUTIES OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

President: He /She shall: (a) preside over all meetings of description. (b) take all disciplinary action. such as removal / dismissal etc in consultation with the Governing Body (c) advice the Secretary on any matter requiring urgent attention. (d) call emergency meeting (e) issue general circulars and notices. (f) ensure compliance with the statutory requirements (g) sign and issue pay orders (h) the president who presides over the meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to his ordinary vote and shall be competent to give his/her ruling and decision on the interpretation of the rules of the Society and such decision shall be final and binding upon the members (I) the president shall be the ex-officio member of all committees and sub committees.

Vice President: In the absence of the president, one of the Vice- Presidents shall perform the all the duties of the President

General Secretary General. He/She shall (a) convene all the Meeting s of the Society (b) maintain minute books of all meetings (c) receive all application for membership which shall be placed before the Governing Body (d) sign on behalf of the Society - all receipts for sums received as subscription, donations, membership/Life membership Fees etc. (e) sign and issue pay orders on an all bills for payment (f) get the accounts of the Society audited by a Chartered Accountant (g) Issue appointment Letters (h) transact all other business subject to the direction of the Governing Body (I) submit a report to the President and the members.

Assistant Secretary: In the absence of the Secretary , Assistant Secretary shall perform the all the duties of the Secretary

Treasurer: He/she (a) collect and receive all sorts of subscriptions, donations and deposit money, membership fees and issue receipts thereof (b) maintain and keep cash book and such other accounts as are necessary and issue pay order on bills for payments and arrange for payment .

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12. Governing Body : There shall be a Governing Body consisting of not less than 5(Five) and not more than 10(Ten) to look after the day to day affairs of the Society. The office bearer of the Governing Body shall consist of President , Vice- president , Secretary General , Assistant Secretary , Treasurer and members. The Governing Body shall normally meet at least once in every three calendar months.

CHAPTER - V :-

- 13. Meeting Of The Governing Body (1) The ordinary meeting of the Governing Body shall be held at least once in three calendar months at such place, date and time as the President/Secretary may determine from time to time.
- (ii) Any emergency meeting of the Governing Body may be called by the President /Secretary.
- (iii) The requisition meeting may be called pursuant to the requisition of at least 5 (five) members of which not more than 3 (three) shall be office bearers.
- (iv) Any member failing to attend three consecutive meeting of the Governing Body and such vacancy shall be filled in through a bye-election.
- 44. Notice and quorum: Seven days notice of the meeting specifying the place, time and the general thature of business to be transacted shall be given to every member of the Governing Body. Emergency meeting may be called on 24 hours notice. Four members personally present shall constitute quorum for the meeting and if a quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the time , members present shall adjourn the meeting.
- 15. Procedure of the Meeting: The President or in his absence the vice -president shall preside over all meetings of the Governing Body and in their absence, members present shall elect a Chairman of the meeting. All question before the meeting will be decided by a majority of votes , each member having one vote. The Fresident or the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote in addition to his own vote in case of equality of votes.
- 16. Annual General Meeting: asper Section LE of the NASR Act 1961
- (i) Notice: The Secretary shall annually call the Annual General Meeting giving at least 14 days' notice to all members . The notice shall contain the Place , date ,day and time of the meeting.
- (ii) Agenda: The business to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting shall be : (a) to confirm the minutes of the Last Annual General Meeting and of special general meeting if any (b) to adopt the report of the working of the Society for the previous year (c) to approve the audited accounts of the Society for the previous year (d) to appoint qualified Auditors (c) to transact such business as may be fixed by the Governing Body. (f) to transact such other business as may be brought forward by giving 14 days previous notice from any member (g) to conduct general election at interval of three years.
- (iii) Quorum of the Meeting :

One third members personally present at the commencement of the Meeting shall constitute the Quorum. If a quorum is not present within 30 minutes after the scheduled time, the members present shall adjourn the meeting

(iv) Manner and method of voting:

The Chairman of the meeting shall decide the manner and method of voting at the outset of the meeting. 17. Special General Meeting :

A Special General Meeting may be convened by the Governing Body at any time in view of urgency of the matter. At least 7 days notice shall be given to every member for special meeting. Members may request the GOVERNING BODY for special general meeting by placing a requisition signed by one third of total members. In that case the GOVERNING BODY shall convene special general meeting within a month from the receipt of such notice. In default by the GOVERNING BODY the requisitionists shall hold such meeting provided no business other than those specified in the notice shall be transacted.

18. Extra -Ordinary General Meeting: The Governing Body may direct to convene an Extra -Ordinary General Meeting for consideration of addition, alteration or amendment of the Memorandum / Regulation of the Society 7 (seveh) days notice along with the proposed draft of changes to memorandum and regulation s to be carried out if accepted by three fourths of the members present at the meeting.

CHAPTER VI

19. Safe Custody Of Properties :- The Governing Body of the Society shall be responsible for the safe custody of the Funds, Properties and assets of the Society.

The Funds of the Society shall be kept in Banks , Post Office , Mutual Funds, Non-Banking Financial Companies and be invested in any securities as specified under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882. 20. Books Of Account and Inspection :- The Books of accounts and other Statutory books shall be kept at the Registered Office and shall be open to inspection of the member at such time and place as the Governing Body directs on a written request made by any member.

21. Accounting Year :- The Accounting Year of the Society shall be from the 1st Day of April of each rear to 31st Day of March of the following year . Hewever, the Accounting Year may be changed depending upon the change of Income Tax Act with regard to Assessment Year.

22. Maintenance and Audit of Accounts :- The Society shall maintain books of accounts as required under section 15(a) (b) of the Act. The accounts shall be audited by qualified Chartered Accountant.

23 Sulfs and Legal Proceedings :- All suits and legal proceedings by or against the Society shall be in the name of the Secretary or such person as shall be appointed by Governing Body.

24.Money and Bank Account - All money belonging to the Society shall be deposited in the name of the in the name of FEDERATION OF INDIAN PHOTOGRAPHY in bank/s to be selected by the Governing Body who shall authorise President , Secretary , Treasurer to operate such Banking account or accounts. The signatories for operating such account or accounts shall be any two of the above mentioned authorised persons jointly.

25. Alteration of Memorandum and regulations :- The Memorandum and Regulations may be altered . modified, rescind or added to by Special resolution passed by $3/4^{\rm th}$ of the members attended in a General Meeting called for the purpose.

The Governing Body shall have powers to make, after, modify or rescind such Bye-laws and rules as may be considered necessary in the interest of smooth functioning of the Society.

26. Amalgamation in case of need :- The Society may be amalgamated with any other Trust/ Society having same nature of activities and the amalgamation may take into effect when the majority decision will be taken by Society. In the General Body Meeting called for the purpose in favour of amalgamation with those organisation/s which is fara registered u/s #2A of the Income Tax Act 1961.

27.DISSOLUTION OF THE SOCIETY :- Subject to the provisions of section 24 & 27 of the West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1981 or any Statutory modification thereof the Society may be dissolved by a resolution to that effect passed by 3/4th members of Society attended at a General Meeting. The said meeting shall also decide the manner of disbursement of the Funds and Assets of the Society, if any after dissolution. The See assets of the Society (after realising all assets and payment of all liabilities) shall be transferred to any Society / Trust in India, which is registered u/s12A of the Income Tax Act 1961.
